The North-East of Scotland is renowned for its quality products which include Baxters, still a family run company after 125 years. This full day tour combines a visit to the Baxters' Highland village with a tour of Duff House, an imposing mansion house by William Adam.

Set amidst beautiful park land, close to the North Sea shores Duff House is the first stop, after a journey through the rolling Buchan countryside. A magnificent example of Baroque architecture dating from 1735, Duff House is now a premier outstation of the National Galleries of Scotland from which it has drawn its rich collection of paintings. A rich cultural programme is held here every year and there are excellent opportunities to organise special events for cruise passengers.

The next stop is at Baxter's Highland village where the Baxter story began in the last century. What started as a small grocery shop in 1868 is now a world famous business. Guests step back in time in the old village shop and can enjoy the unique food theatre to see how Baxters products are made, and learn how to use the techniques back home.
